What is included in the PHS Viewer?



Clinical data in the Lab, Summary, Search, and LMR views include results, reports, notes, and other clinical documentation through 12/31/2017. The historical allergy record ends 10/31/2019. Data for the MGH Orders, MGH eMAR, and DFPC COE Orders views are from the legacy systems, and do not include any information from Epic. For patient information created after the cutoff dates, check the Epic chart.

LMR Views – Before implementation of Partners Epic eCare, the Longitudinal Medical Record (LMR) was used primarily by primary care physicians as a tool for documenting ambulatory patient visits.

Consolidated Medications List Viewer (CMLV) – History of medications from LMR and OnCall, sorted by drug class.

Allergy History viewer – History of active and inactive allergies and reactions created for the patient in the Partners Enterprise Allergy Repository, up until the end date of 10/31/2019.

Chemo Order Entry (COE) Orders viewer - Historical chemotherapy order sessions for Dana-Farber Partners Cancer Care sites (DFPC) at MGH, NSMC/IN, DFCI, and BWH/FH.

MGH Order Entry (POE) viewer - Historical order sessions written in the MGH Orders (POE) application in CAS, before the implementation of Partners eCare on April 1, 2016.

MGH eMAR viewer - This view displays historical medication administration documentation that was entered in the MGH eMAR application in CAS, before the implementation of Partners eCare on April 1, 2016.



Who has access to the PHS Viewer?

Available from Epic for all users with access to the Chart Review activity, PHS Viewer works within the clinical workflow for the selected Epic patient. PHS Viewer provides one-click access to historical clinical data that may not be viewable elsewhere in Epic.
