Epic Storyboard – Adding PHS Viewer to the patient chart

The Epic Storyboard layout moves to general use for eCare on August 23, 2020. This layout does not include a tab for the PHS Viewer by default, but you can easily add one to the chart.

Adding a PHS Viewer tab

1. Click 🌽 at the top right.



The Customize Workspace view displays, with high-level instructions 'penciled-in.' The default tabs depend on your role – you can add or remove any as needed.

- 4. Drag to the place you want it in the tabs, and then release the mouse pointer.
